

**National Chengchi University College of Science Guidelines for Research Grants for Newly Appointed Faculty Members**

Explanations for Newly Established Provisions

<b><i>Proposed Article</i></b>		<b><i>Explanation</i></b>
Article 1	The College of Science at National Chengchi University (hereinafter referred to as the College) has established these regulations to encourage new faculty members to promote academic research.	Purpose of establishment
Article 2	The College establishes these Guidelines for Research Grants for Newly Appointed Faculty Members. The recipients of the grant shall be newly appointed full-time faculty members of the College.	Eligible recipients
Article 3	The grant covers the purchase of research-related consumables, stationery, equipment, and instruments. Other items not directly related to research—such as furniture, small appliances, coffee machines, and vacuum cleaners—are not eligible for subsidy. Each faculty member may apply to purchase only one personal computer.	Subsidized items
Article 4	Each newly appointed full-time faculty member may receive a grant of up to NT\$100,000. Each person may apply only once, and reimbursement must be completed within one year after the effective date of appointment.	Grant amount and application period
Article 5	Funding sources: 1. The College's Higher Education Sprout Project. 2. The College's administrative and management funds. Reimbursement shall be handled in accordance with the regulations of the Higher Education Sprout Office and related university rules.	Funding sources and reimbursement regulations
Article 6	These guidelines shall be implemented after approval by the relevant College-level meeting and promulgation by the Dean. The same procedure applies to any amendments.	Implementation and amendment procedures
