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# College of Science Academic Journal Publication Subsidy Regulations, National Chengchi University

Approved at the **115th College Affairs Meeting** on **October 28, 2019** (entire text initially approved)

## Article 1

The College of Science, National Chengchi University (hereinafter referred to as “the College”), in order to encourage outstanding academic research performance by full-time faculty members, hereby promulgates these Regulations.

## Article 2

Subsidies for academic journal publications shall be administered once each academic year, with an application deadline of April 1. Eligible applications shall be limited to academic articles that were accepted for publication or published within one year prior to the application deadline, and that are published under the affiliation “National Chengchi University.”

The following shall not be eligible for subsidy: correspondence, review, book review, correct, reply, editorial, and other non-academic articles.

## Article 3

Subsidies for academic journal publications of the College shall be determined through the complementary application of two evaluation criteria—tiering based on Impact Factor and tiering based on journal rankings within respective disciplines. Applicants may freely choose either criterion. The classification standards, subsidy amounts, and disbursement methods are outlined in the table below:

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(V)	Articles published in SCI/SSCI journals ranked within the top 1–25% of their respective disciplines according to the latest <i>Journal Citation Reports (JCR)</i> , or articles in international journals or international conference proceedings of equivalent standing <sup>Note 1</sup>	NT\$20,000

Note 1: For subsidy categories (IV) and (V), the list of international journals and international conferences of equivalent standing is provided in the appendix.

Note 2: In principle, a single article that has already received other funding or subsidies from the University or the College shall not be eligible for duplicate or concurrent subsidies.

#### Article 4

Full-time faculty members affiliated with the College who have served for at least one year and have published articles under the affiliation “National Chengchi University” may apply to the College for subsidies.

For co-authored articles, scores shall be calculated using weighted allocation: 70% for the first author or corresponding author, and 10% for other authors. Only one applicant may submit a subsidy application for the same article.

If the order of authorship is not determined by contribution, applicants shall provide a statement explaining individual contributions along with documentation of the proportional ranking.

For jointly appointed full-time faculty members, those whose primary appointment unit is the College shall be subject to the College’s subsidy principles for full-time faculty.

#### Article 5

Recipients of the subsidy shall provide a Chinese abstract of the published article and agree to participate in related interviews, as necessary, to assist in the promotion of science communication and public outreach.

#### Article 6

Applicants for academic journal publication subsidies shall submit the following documents:

- (1) The full text of the article.
- (2) For published articles, a photocopy of the table of contents of the journal issue in which the article was published.
- (3) For articles that have been accepted but not yet published, an official letter of acceptance.
- (4) Supporting documentation for the applied article, including journal ranking tier, impact factor, and other relevant evidentiary materials.

(5) A preliminary review and confirmation form issued by the applicant's affiliated department (or program).

#### Article 7

After applications have undergone preliminary review by the respective departments (programs), the Dean shall convene a meeting of administrative supervisors to conduct the review. Applications shall then be reviewed and ranked in accordance with the following principles:

(1) Within the same category of articles, ranking shall begin with applicants of shorter academic seniority, in the order of Assistant Professor, Associate Professor, and Professor.

For applicants holding the same academic rank, ranking priority shall be determined by length of service at the College of Science, with those of shorter service receiving priority.

(2) Among all applications submitted by applicants at the same rank, one application with the highest requested subsidy amount from each applicant shall first be included in the ranking.

After each applicant has been ranked once, the next highest-amount application from the same applicant shall be considered, and so forth.

(3) Journal Impact Factors shall be determined based on the values listed in the Journal Citation Reports (JCR) database for the year of application.

If the Impact Factor for the application year is not yet available, the most recent prior year's data shall be applied, with retrospective reference limited to a maximum of three years.

#### Article 8

The annual subsidy budget and the maximum subsidy amount per applicant shall each be NTS\$600,000.

If the total approved subsidy amounts exceed the available budget for any category, priority shall be given to newly appointed faculty members.

#### Article 9

If an applicant is found to have violated these Regulations or other applicable laws or regulations, the Committee may revoke the subsidy and demand full reimbursement of the subsidized funds.

The applicant shall bear all related expenses, including income tax and supplementary premiums for the Second-Generation National Health Insurance (both the individual and employer portions).

#### Article 10

Funding for these Regulations shall be derived from the College of Science Program for Enhancing Academic Research Outcomes, the College's administrative management fees, and internal and external subsidy or grant funds.

#### Article 11

These Regulations shall be promulgated and implemented by the Dean upon approval by the College Affairs Meeting. The same shall apply to any amendments thereto.
